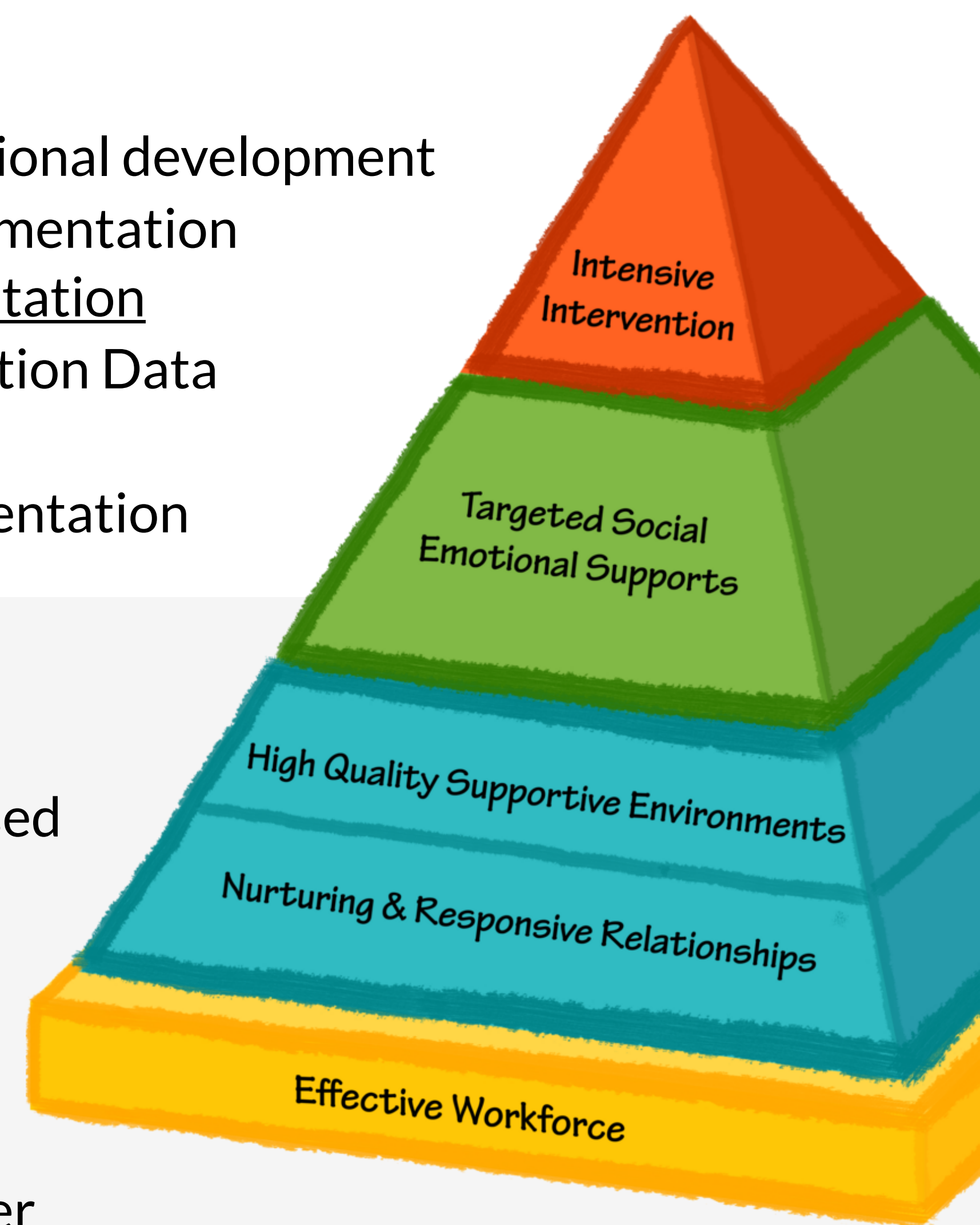


Interested in exploring Pyramid Model Implementation?

What is the Pyramid Model?

The Pyramid Model is a tiered intervention framework of evidence-based practices for supporting social-emotional competence in infants and young children.

The impact of these efforts for program-wide implementation includes:

- Increases in children’s social skills
- Reductions in child challenging behavior
- Increased satisfaction of program staff and families
- Reduced staff turnover
- Improved family engagement
- Increases in teachers’ competence and confidence in the support of children
