Legislative Update 56th Second Regular Session

ADE introduced five bills this session:

- 1. SB 1466 high school graduation; requirements
- 2. SB 1385 school letter grades; student discipline
- 3. SB 1414 retirement; reemployment; school resource officers
- 4. HB 2400 school safety program; proposals
- 5. HB 2779 Holocaust education; instruction requirements
