

Data regarding school-aged children with IEPs (age 5 and in kindergarten through age 21) during the 2022–2023 school year.







69.1%

of school-aged children with IEPs were served inside the general education classroom 80% or more of the school day, compared to the national average at 67%.

15.5%

of school-aged children with IEPs were served inside the general education classroom less than 80% but more than 40% of the school day, compared to the national average at 20.1%.





12.8%

of school-aged children with IEPs were served inside the general education classroom 40% or less of the school day, compared to the national average at 12.5%.

2.6%

of school-aged children with IEPs were served in separate schools, residential facilities, or home-based/hospital placements, compared to the national average at 3.4%.
