FOR MILITARY KIDS CHANGING SCHOOLS

- Vaccination and medical records
- Most recent report card
- School work samples
- Copies of standardized test results
- Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or 504 Plan for special needs kids
- Gifted and Talented (GT) plan - if applicable
- Notes from conferences
- Teachers notes
- Copy of orders
- Proof of residence
- Consider letters of recommendation if your child is:
 - a talented athlete, musician, debater, artist, etc.
 - in 11th or 12th grade
 - gifted or placed in special education
 - applying to private schools
- Take a quick peek at potential schools online. Try to find as many reviews of the school as possible, or even reach out via social media to current families.
- On registration day, bring your education binder, photo IDs and social security cards (just to be safe).
- Pick up the supply lists and ask about Meet the Teacher Day in the fall. This is also a great time to ask about school or town run summer programs!
