Local program and business needs may necessitate the purchase of additional equipment and software resources, as may the rapidly-changing nature of the industry-specific technologies used in the program.

Recommended Equipment and Software

Item	Notes
*Computer workstation with standard and program-required input devices and ports (mouse, keyboard, USB etc.)	Both macOS and Windows computer workstations are acceptable, provided the computer hardware, graphics hardware, sound/audio hardware, RAM, hard-disk space, and operating system software are capable of efficiently running all installed software applications and supporting any and all attached peripherals. Consult the product specifications for all program-specific software applications to ensure that computer workstations meet minimum recommended hardware requirements.
Computer display	Minimum 21-inch monitor capable of displaying full HD resolution or higher.
Secure network storage space for digital files	For projects and student portfolios; server- or cloud-based.
Laser printer	Color laser printer preferred. A multi-function laser printer (printer, photocopier, and scanner) would also be appropriate.
Digital drawing tablet	Wacom Intuos or similar.
Flatbed scanner	Large format scan area (11 in. x 17 in. or larger) recommended.
Digital camera (including all required components and accessories: memory cards, cables, rechargeable batteries, carrying case, lenses, etc.)	Point-and-shoot or DSLR; resolution of 12 megapixels or higher; able to capture HD video.

Locking storage cabinets	Should have enough capacity to safely store all program equipment and to allow for convenient access and equipment check-in/out.
Adobe Creative Cloud, which includes Adobe Photoshop, Adobe Premiere, Adobe After Effects, Adobe Animate, and other essential, industry-standard creative desktop applications	Software applications should be no more than one version behind the current release..

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3D Creation Software such as Autodesk Maya, Autodesk 3ds Max, or Blender	Software applications should be no more than one version behind the current release.
Microsoft Office Suite, which includes Microsoft Word, Microsoft PowerPoint, Microsoft Excel, and other essential, industry-standard productivity software applications	Software applications should be no more than one version behind the current release.
Portable/laptop computer workstations	To be used for CTSO competitions. Specifications equal to the desktop workstations listed above.

Apple Final Cut Pro (Apple Macintosh compatible only)	Software applications should be no more than one version behind the current release.
Apple Motion (Apple Macintosh compatible only)	Software applications should be no more than one version behind the current release.
Render farm	NOTE: A render farm is a high-performance computer system built to render computer-generated imagery.
