

2022-2023 Arizona State Seal of Biliteracy Annual Report

On May 12, 2016, SB1239 was signed into law establishing the Ariona State Seal of Biliteracy Program. This program recognizes high school students who achieve proficiency in English and at least one additional language. The seal is placed on the student's diploma and noted on the transcript. Specific requirements are listed in A.R.S. § 15-258.

During the 2022-2023 school year, 30 local education agencies participated in the Seal of Biliteracy Program. This number included 23 school districts and seven charter schools. Five counties were represented - Coconino, Maricopa, Pinal, Navajo and Pima.

1658 seals were awarded to graduating seniors compared to 1421 for the 2022 graduating class. Of those 1658 students, 309 students were designated as English Language Learners at some point during their K-12 academic journey. 727 students attended Title 1 schools. Languages that have previously been test but were not this year includes Hebrew. New languages tested for the 2022-2023 school year include: Bengali, Macedonian, Navajo, Tagalog, Romanian, Serbian, Serbo-Croatian, and Polish.

Students earned seals in twenty-one different languages. These languages were:
