



2022-2023 Arizona State Seal of Personal Finance Annual Report

In 2017, A.R.S. §15-260 was signed into law establishing the Arizona State Seal of Personal Finance Program. This program recognizes high school students who achieve a high level of proficiency in personal finance concepts. Students earning the Seal of Personal Finance have completed all required social studies courses with a grade point average of 3.0 out of a 4.0 scale, passed a personal finance assessment, and completed at least three personal finance activities which include an approved personal finance curriculum course with a grade of B or better, an approved co-curricular or extra-curricular activity, and completed a college or career readiness plan. The seal is placed on the student's diploma and noted on the transcript. Specific requirements for the Seal of Personal Finance are listed in A.R.S. § 15-260.

During the 2022-2023 school year, we had 24 school districts complete the Intent to Participate. Of those, five school districts had students earn the Seal of Personal Finance. A total of 471 students obtained the Seal of Personal Finance with 107 of those students attending Title I schools.
