• AzEDS

- New exit code W31: Long-term suspension only
 - Exit Code W3: Expelled before scheduled end of school year only

Identify Your Errors (slide 1 of 2)

Check your SPED72 Report in the AzEDS Portal

The SPED72 report will show all students reported to AzEDS with SPED needs and/or SPED Program participation, ELL participation, and whether they have passed FED SPED and State SPED integrity.

Identify Your Errors (slide 2 of 2)

Check your INTEG15 Report in the AzEDS Portal

The INTEG15 report displays a post-integrity list of student data related to membership and their integrity status results. Drill down using the filters to identify students at a specific site (optional), Integrity Status as 'Failed,' and Integrity Category of 'SPED' and 'Fed SPED.'

Integrity Error -40088 (slide 1 of 2)

• Error Message

- SPED Preschool Students must be reported with three Preschool Outcomes Assessments upon exit. Please refer to the ESS Preschool Outcomes Reporting Guidance document
- 13,953 instances as of May 12
- Common Issues
 - One or more exit outcomes assessments missing per LRE exit date, or excess outcomes reported
 - Per ECSE, this rating is expected to be submitted within 15 days after the child exits the preschool special education program on all three outcome areas

Integrity Error -40088 (slide 2 of 2)

Troubleshooting

- SPED Preschool Students must be reported with three Preschool Outcome Assessments upon exit.
 - You have up to 15 calendar days after exit date to enter outcomes
- Review the SPED11 and SPED12 Reports
- Review ADE ESS's <u>Assessing Outcomes for Preschool Children</u> with Disabilities, Review <u>Preschool Outcomes Reporting</u> <u>Guidance</u>

Integrity Error -40087 (slide 1 of 2)

• Error Message

 SPED Preschool Students must be reported with three Preschool Outcome Assessments upon entry. Please refer to the ESS Preschool Outcomes Reporting Guidance document.

Common Issues

- One or more entry assessments missing per LRE start date or excess assessments reported.
 - Per ECSE, an entry score must be submitted without delay and no later than two weeks after enrollment in the program on all three outcome areas. Integrity will fail until the information is provided.

Integrity Error -40087 (slide 2 of 2)

Troubleshooting

- Review -40087 Integrity Error Tool,
- Review the ESS Preschool Outcomes Reporting Guidance document, Review ADE ESS's Assessing Outcomes for Preschool Children with Disabilities
- Review SPED12 for SPED Preschool Outcomes History
- Ensure that each Preschool LRE code has three different Entry Outcomes and then sync to AzEDS.

Integrity Error -40055

- Error Message
 - Invalid exit code combination; refer to the <u>SPED Exit</u> <u>Validation matrix</u>
- 21,065 instances as of May 12
- If a student's SPED Exit Reason does not align with the student's enrollment year-end or withdrawal enrollment status, then report the discrepancy as an error.

Integrity Error -40055 (slide 2 of 2)

 SPED Exit Code 3 can oly be used for students 21 yrs or older. SPED Exit Code 10 can only be used with PS, K, and UE grades. SPED Exit Code 14 can only be used with PS grade. Special Education Data Updates

Out-of-Scope Topics

Extended School Year (ESY) (slide 1 of 2)

- Special education and related services that are provided to a child with a disability beyond the normal school year according to a child's IEP.
 - IDEA requires IEP teams to determine (on an individual basis) whether ESY services are necessary to provide FAPE.
- Eligibility for ESY services shall be determined no later than 45 calendar days prior to the last day of the school year.

Extended School Year (ESY) (slide 2 of 2)

• Reporting

 PEAs do not have to report ESY services for students with disabilities to AzEDS
