



2023-2024 Arizona State Seal of Civics Literacy Annual Report

In 2017, A.R.S. §15-259 was signed into law establishing the Arizona State Seal of Civics Literacy Program. This program recognizes high school students who achieve a high level of proficiency in civics. Students earning the Seal of Civics Literacy have completed all required social studies courses with a grade point average of 3.0 out of a 4.0 scale, passed the Arizona Civics Exam with a 60% or higher, completed at least three civic learning programs, at least two civic engagement activities, performed at least 75 hours of service learning or community service, and completed a written reflection. The seal is placed on the student's diploma and noted on the transcript. Specific requirements for the Seal of Civics Literacy are listed in A.R.S. § 15-259.

During the 2023-2024 school year, 83 students from 11 school districts reported students obtained the Seal of Civics Literacy. Of these students, 66 students were from Title I schools.
