






Foster Care Data

Children in Department of Child Safety (Total- 8,678)



Foster Care Mobility



20,300 Moves a year**55.58** Moves a day



2.20 Moves per child

Foster Care School Stability Steps

Student enters foster care or has a change in foster care placement

Student remains at the school of origin while the Local Education Agency & child welfare agency execute the Best

Interest Determination process

Best Interest Determination Outcome: Stay in School of Origin

Local Education Agency & child welfare agency collaborate on transportation

Best Interest Determination

Best Interest Determination
Outcome: Do Not Stay in School of
Origin

The new school immediately enrolls the student, even without all paperwork.





SEA Assurances

School Stability

Children in foster care remain in their school of origin.

"(i)... remains in such child's school of origin, unless a determination is made that it is not in such child's best interest;" -- 1111(g)(1)(E)(i)

Immediate Enrollment



"(ii)... not in such child's best interest to remain in the school of origin, the child is immediately enrolled in a new school..." -- 1111(g)(1)(E)(ii)

Academic & Other Records

New school \rightarrow get the previous records.

"(iii) the **enrolling school** shall **immediately contact** the **school last attended** by any such child to **obtain** relevant academic and other **records**" -- 1111(g)(1)(E)(iii)

SEA Foster Care Point of Contact


SEA FC POC collaborates w/ LEA & CWA & cannot be the Homeless State Coordinator.

"(iv) the **SEA** will designate an employee to serve as a **point of contact** for child welfare agencies and to **oversee implementation** of the State agency responsibilities,... such point of contact **shall not** be the State's Coordinator for **EHCY**" -- 1111(g)(1)(E)(iv)

Clear Written Procedures

School of Origin transportation for the duration of time in foster care.

"(B) ... develop and implement clear written procedures governing how transportation to maintain children in foster care in their school of origin when in their best interest will be provided, arranged, and funded for the duration of the time in foster care..." -- 1112(c)(5)(B)

Collaborative Transportation



"... shared responsibility of CWAs and LEAs to ensure educational stability..." -- <u>Joint Guidance</u> "(i)... transportation to the school of origin will promptly receive transportation in a cost-effective manner..." -- <u>1112(c)(5)(B)(i)</u>

Child Welfare Agency Reimburses (1112(c)(5)(B)(ii)(I))

"(ii) ensure that, if there are **additional costs** incurred in providing transportation to maintain children in foster care in their schools of origin, the **LEA** will **provide transportation** to the **school of origin** if..." -- 1112(c)(5)(B)(ii)
