

# Reporting DD, PSD, MD, and MDSSI

EdFacts guidance, per the FS002 – Children with Disabilities (IDEA) School Age File Specification, requires that, in circumstances where more than one disability is reported for a student, the data is federally reported publicly using the following hierarchy.

# **Primary Need Hierarchy**

PEAs should utilize the following logic when reporting students with disabilities:

- 1. If the student has DD or PSD, the PEA should report the student with one of these categories being the primary disability
- 2. If the student does not have DD or PSD and the student has either MD or MDSSI, the PEA should report the student with MD or MDSSI as the primary disability
- 3. If the student does not meet criteria 1 or 2, the PEA may report any primary disability

# **MD Requirements**

MD requires the following categories to co-exist:

Two or more of the following: HI, MOID, OI, VI

## OR

• One of the above categories

### **AND**

One of the following: ED, EDP, MIID, SLD

Subject to other existing rules and providing that this rule is met, any other category may co-exist with MD.

#### **MDSSI** Requirements

MDSSI requires the following categories to co-exist:

Severe HI and VI

#### OR

One of the above categories

#### **AND**

One of the following: A, EDP, MOID, OI, SID

Subject to other existing rules and providing that this rule is met, any other category may co-exist with MDSSI.
