1 Meals served to teachers, administrators, custodians, and other adults were not priced so that the adult payment in combination with any per-lunch revenues from other sources designated specifically for the support of adult meals (such as State or local fringe benefit or payroll funds, or funding from voluntary agencies) was sufficient to cover the overall cost of the meal. Specifically, adult lunches were priced at \$4.75 when they should have been priced https://www.azed.gov/hns/nslp/forms/ under at \$ 4.84.

For Non-Pricing Sites: pricing adult meals to reflect the amount of the per meal value of entitlement and bonus meal price charged and the required adult commodities for non-pricing programs.
