Specifically, Isaac Middle School was operating breakfast and lunch services June 2-12, 2025 with no approved site application.	Discussed that under the Food Program Permanent Service Agreement (FPPSA) with the Arizona Department of Education, the sponsor agreed to only serve meals at the approved sites.	A site application for Isaac Middle School was submitted on June 12, 2025. Please submit written assurance that meals will not be claimed at sites that have not been approved to operate.					
2	Meals served to non-Program adults were not priced appropriately to cover the cost of the meal at Pueblo Del Sol Middle School. Specifically, the SFA is charging \$2.35 for breakfast and \$4.10 for lunch when the minimum requirement is \$2.84 for breakfast and \$4.84 for lunch.	Discussed ways to determine adult meal prices which included a per meal cost analysis or pricing adult meals to reflect the amount of reimbursement received for a free meal plus the per meal value of donated foods.	Please provide a written description of the steps which have been taken to increase adult meal prices, including the exact formula used to price adult meals. Additionally, please provide documentation demonstrating the prices have been increased to the appropriate level and documentation supporting that the difference between the charged price and required price has been restored to the nonprofit school food service account using non-Federal funds during the month of June 2025.
