

## **ADE Mathematics Instructional Minutes Recommendations**

- Students should receive a minimum of 60 minutes of math instruction per day.
- Lessons can be a combination of whole-group and small-group instruction.
- The ratio of student voice and teacher voice should be 80% to 20%, respectively, where students are working collaboratively.
