



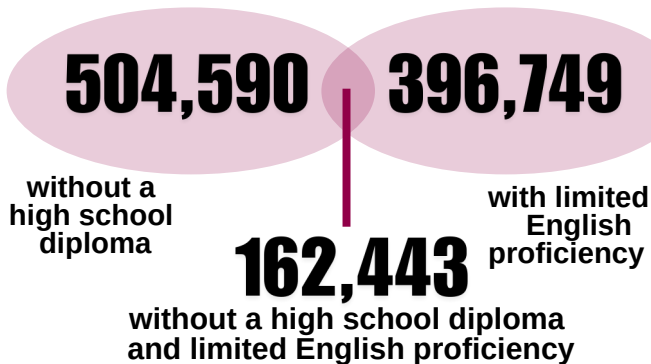
Building a Strong Future: Arizona Adult Education

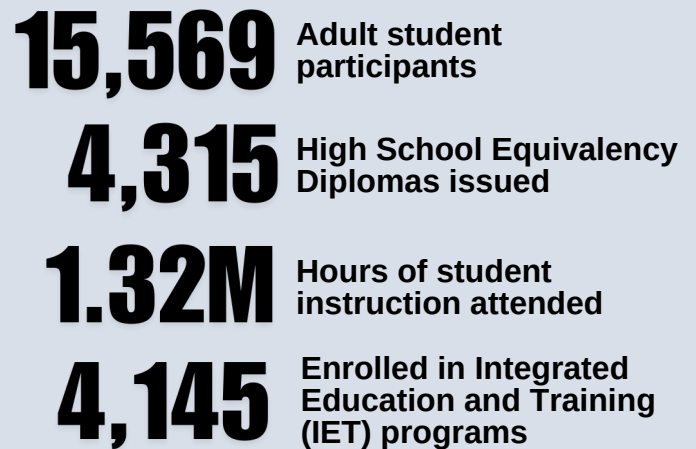
- improve literacy and career pathways
