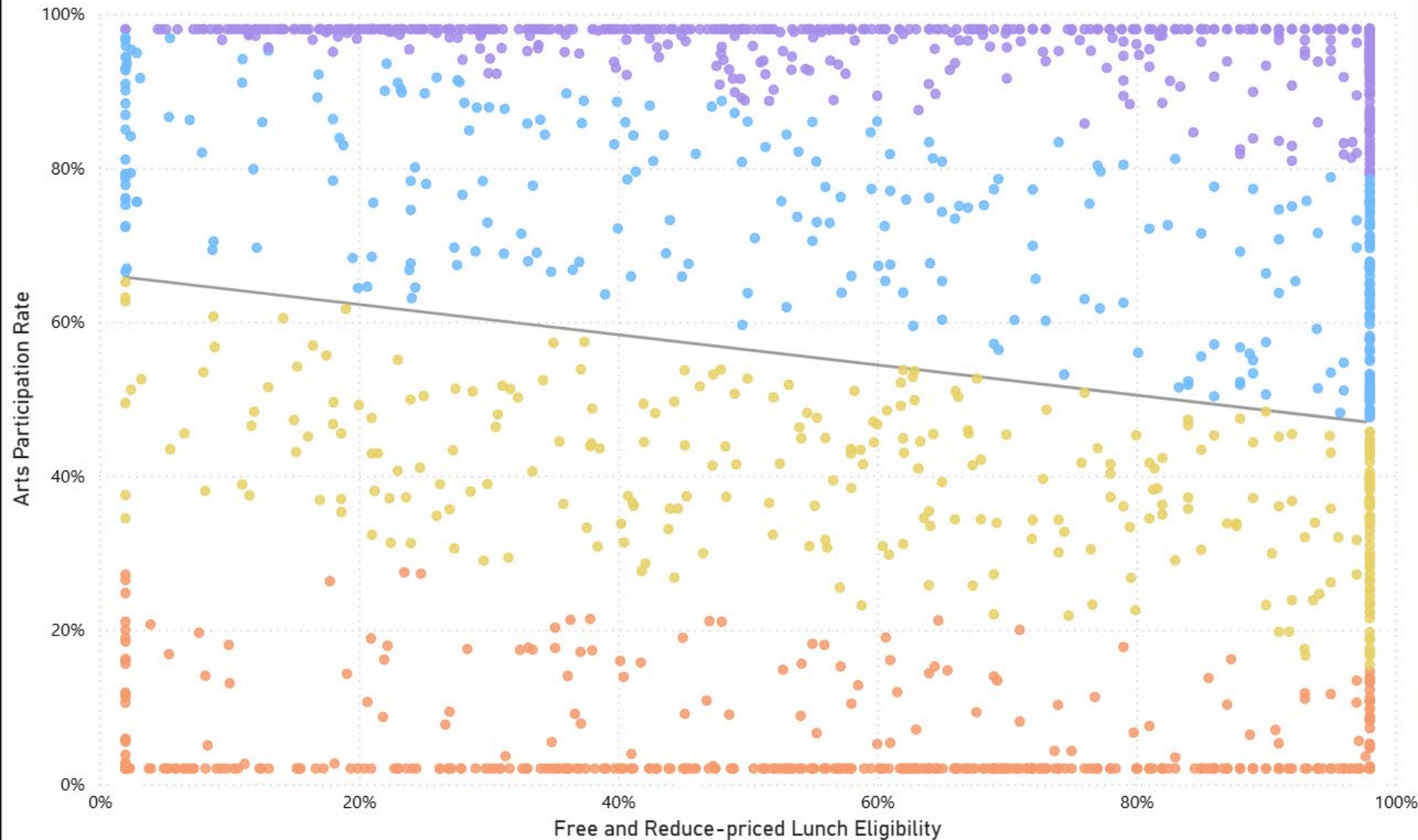

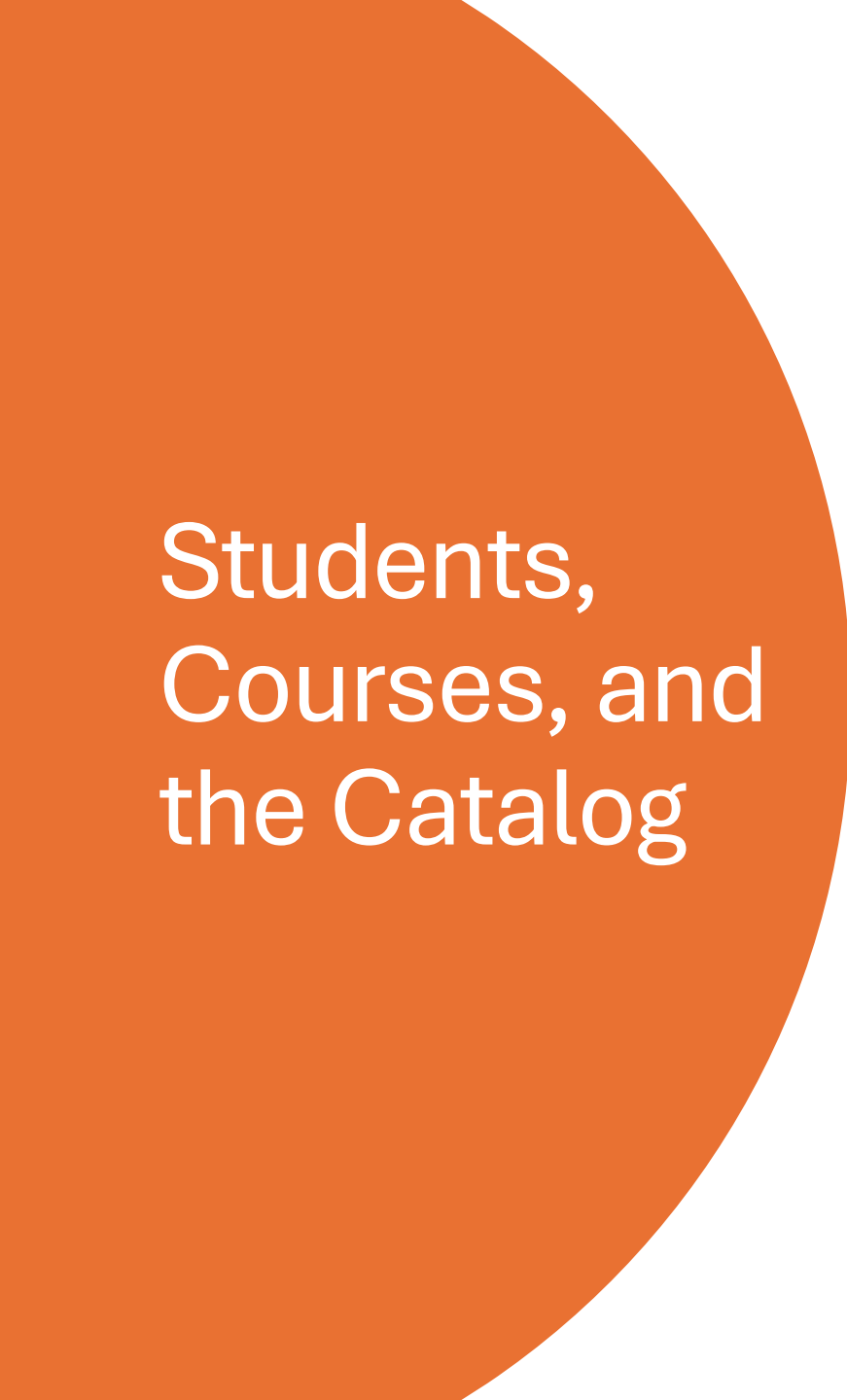

Small Ensemble: AZ55106

- Fine and Performing Arts (prior-to-secondary)
- Small Ensemble courses help students perform a variety of musical styles (e.g., traditional chamber music, jazz, and rock). At the same time, these courses help cultivate students' technique on instruments appropriate to the style(s) performed—brass, woodwind, string, percussion instruments, and/or electronic and provide experiences in creating and responding to music. Courses typically range in size from 2 to 20 performers.

We only look at State Courses by Code

How to make it right

- Ensure every student is *enrolled* in a section
- Ensure every section is associated with the right local course
- Ensure every course is associated with the right STATE course
- Submit all data through STC
 - Often there's a “don't submit” button that avoids integrity errors
 - Often some students just don't have an assignment (esp. Kinder)
- CHECK what you can

How to check – STC10

STC10 - Student-Teacher-Course Verification Report

The STC10 report shows each Section of a Course, the teacher teaching that Course and the students who are/have been enrolled in the course. A user must select at least one School and one Subject Area. If desired, the user can filter the data even more by entering in the first 2 characters of the Local Course ID, or first 1 character of the Section ID or a complete State Student ID. Matching on the Course ID and Section ID are a "starts with" so you can filter based on something that starts with say "AZ01". Matching on the State Student ID is an exact match so make sure the number you are entering is complete and accurate. Clicking the blue circle with an 'i' will take you to the Quick Reference Guide for this report. This report is pre-integrity

**Shows every offered course by teacher,
and all students enrolled.**

- Ensure you've got the right year
- Select ALL terms
- One subject area at a time
 - AZ05 & AZ55 – Fine and Performing Arts;
 - AZ11 & AZ61 – Communication & A/V Tech.
 - AZ08 & AZ58 – Physical, Health, and Safety Education

Guidelines for CRS10

Shows you every student in every course (local).

- One school at a time (unless you're insane)
- Export as CSV
- Open in Excel or Sheets (which should automatically convert)
- SORT by SCED Code – Should be things like AZ01001
 - COUNTIF()
 - UNIQUE()
- Look for MISSING information (entire grades, entire classes)

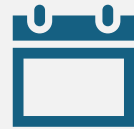

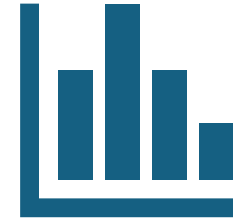

ADE Scrapes all the school-level data for aggregation



Assigns values to each school



Reports in CNA, Arts, and PE Dashboards

Advanced Learning

- Note – there is not yet an ‘easy’ way to check Advanced Learning
- Courses should SAY “AP”, “IB”, “Cambridge”, “Dual Enrollment”
 - Dual Credit/Dual Enrollment are equivalent
 - AP/IB/CIE work UNLESS they are ‘prep’
- Ideally, they’d have the ‘flags’ attached
- Much harder to scrape
 - “MAT150” isn’t useful—too many different versions of too many courses
 - “College” isn’t either—too many courses are ‘college preparatory...’
