How were students identified for the certificate of achievement?

Students were identified to receive this certificate using their scale score for each subject area in each assessed grade level. English Language Arts (ELA) and Math are assessed using the AASA for students in grades 3-8 and the ACT for students in grade 11. Science is assessed using the AZSCI for students in grade 5, 8, and 11. Any student who scored in the top 10% of scale scores in any assessed subject area, per grade level, was identified to receive a certificate. Please see the table below for the minimum score needed in each subject, per grade level, to qualify for the certificate of achievement.
