FY27 IDEA Supplemental Funds

2027 IDEA Part B funds include **supplemental funding** reflecting an additional investment by the federal administration in special education services. The supplemental funding:

- Represents ~ \$4.08 million for K-12 (school-aged) and 3-5 (preschool) subgrants to LEAs distributed in accordance with the applicable statutory formula requirements.
- Is subject to all terms and conditions applicable to the State's FY2027 IDEA Part B grant award, including all statutory and regulatory requirements, assurances, certifications and grant conditions.
- Has the same period of availability as the States FY 2027 IDEA Consolidated Grant.

IDEA Supplemental Award Breakdown

Section 611 – Subgrants to LEAs

- Serves students ages 3–21
- Section 611 of the IDEA Supplemental Grant
- \$4,082,499.00 for FY27 full award
- 638 public education agencies

Section 619 – Subgrants to LEAs

- Serves students ages 3–5, including Kindergarten
- Section 619 of the IDEA Supplemental Grant
- \$320,078.00 for FY27 full award
- 445 public education agencies

Duration of Grant

- This supplemental grant will have a 12-month duration with a 3-month liquidation.
- The term will be from July 1, 2026, through September 30, 2027
- Any funds that are not obligated at the end of the federal funding period specified shall remain available for obligation for an additional period of 12 months.

Grant Information in GME System

The IDEA Supplemental grant application will be accessible through the Grants Management Enterprise System (GME).

Go into ADEConnect>Applications> Grants Management Enterprise System (GME).

Once there, Search dropdown and select Funding Applications.

1. In the search fields, enter the following:
 - **Organization Name:** Enter the PEA name
 - **Fiscal Year:** 2027
 - **Funding Application:** IDEA Supplemental
 - **Status:** All
2. Click **Search** to locate the supplemental grant application for your PEA.

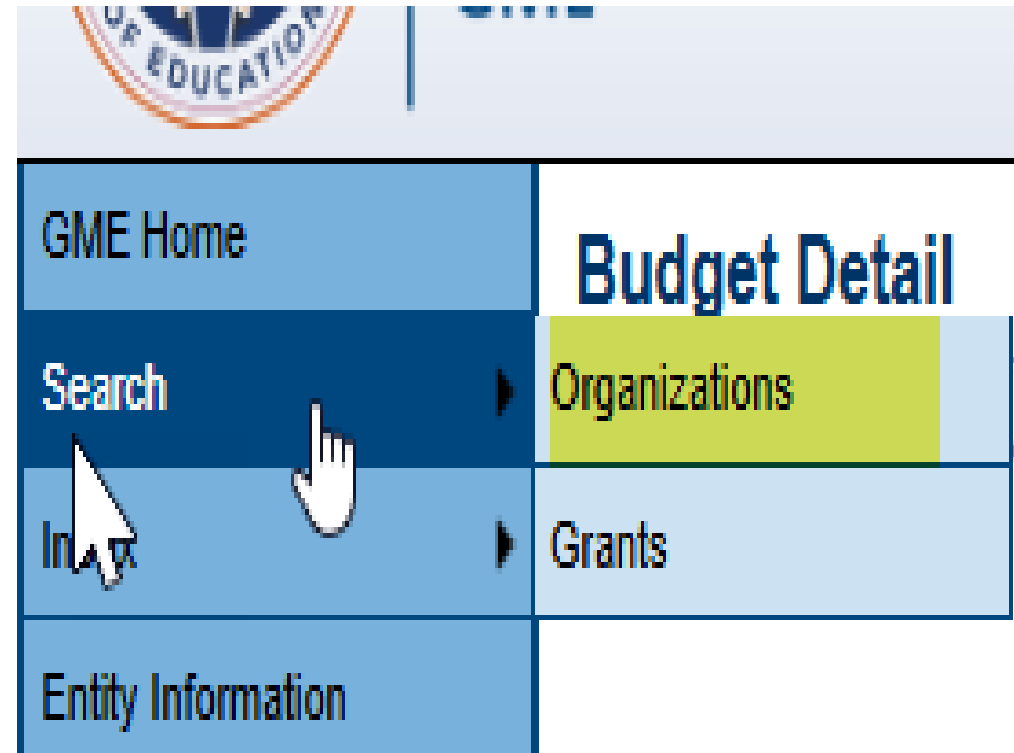

3. Hover over Search dropdown
4. Select Organizations.

Equipment Criteria

If an item is not included in the examples above, it should be coded as equipment if it meets ALL of the following:

1. Typically has a useful life of at least one year.
2. Typically repaired rather than replaced when worn or damaged.
3. An independent unit that retains its original shape, appearance, and character with use and does lose its identity through fabrication or incorporation into a different or more complex unit or substance.

DISCLAIMER FOR CHARTER SCHOOLS

- All capital items with a unit cost of \$5000 or greater MUST have been coded as 0190 within your budget

Once you have completed the sections for your PEA, change status to “LEA IDEA Part B Capital Year End Report Approved” to submit the supplement for review/approval by Program Management Specialist.

This must be completed and approved prior to your completion report’s approval.
