Covers key principles related to budgeting, allowable costs, and maintaining compliance with federal program guidelines. Provides technical guidance aligned with CACFP requirements.

Covers the Administrative Review process. It does not provide a full overview of the CACFP program; instead, it highlights the most common findings during an AR and helps participants review their documentation through the lens of a reviewer.
