# TRAINER INFORMATION SHEET

With funding support through Arizona Project Bright Futures, a SAMHSA-funded grant, the Arizona Department of Education seeks to expand capacity and sustainability for suicide prevention through widespread training access and material support.

## Required ASIST and safeTALK Trainings

- **ASIST:** Provisional trainers (first year trainers) are required to complete **three trainings** within the year. Registered trainers are required to complete **one training** a year.
- **safeTALK:** Provisional trainers (first year trainers) are required to complete **three trainings** within the year. Registered trainers are required to complete **one training** a year.

## Request for Training Materials

**Trainers can request materials for safeTALK and ASIST workshops by completing the ADE Trainer Support Request Form.**

- Requests must be submitted at least 60 days in advance
- Trainers may request kits. One kit includes a 30 count of all safeTALK and ASIST materials.
- Support is limited and based on availability. One trainer is able to receive a maximum of 2 kits a year. ADE will review and approve requests at its discretion.
