All Public Education Agencies (PEAs) are required to complete SEDD

- Data Review
 - SPED Exit Data
 - SPED Discipline Data
 - Students without Disabilities (SWOD)
- Data Certification

Important Dates

- July 15, 2026: Student data deadline
 - All student data in AzEDS must be corrected in PEA's SIS
- July 22, 2026: Data Certification opens
- August 5, 2026: Data Certification deadline
 - LEA Signer must complete by 5:00 p.m.





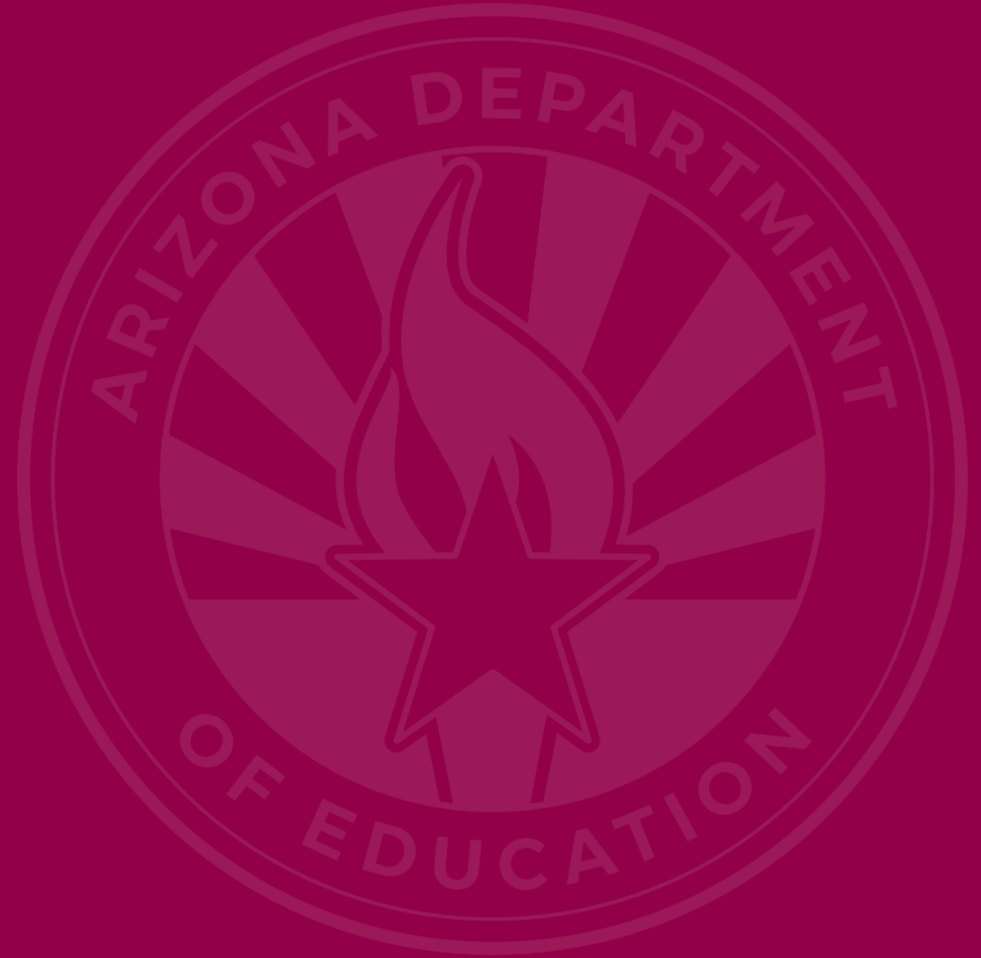

SPED Exit Requirements

Student must meet the following qualifications to be included in the SPED Exit Data capture:

- Enrolled in SPED services on first day of school year, as applicable
- Age 14–21 years (based on October 1)
- Passing integrity
- Last known exit must be 1 of the 6 Federal Exit Categories

Services on the First In-Session Day

Student must be enrolled and receiving SPED services on the first in-session day

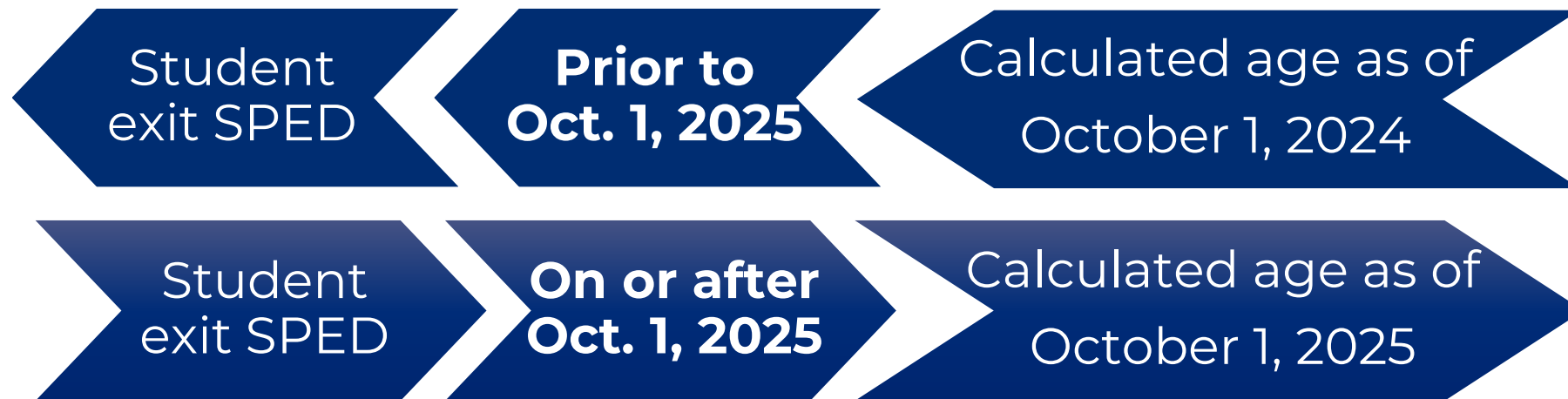
- Based on LEA Calendar in AzEDS
- Arizona Online Instruction (AOI) and Dropout Recovery Program (DRP) have 8 weeks from July 1
- If student was enrolled after the first in-session day, student will not be included

If not within your PEA:

- Collaborate with the PEA where the student enrolled at the beginning of the school year

Exit: Age Calculation

Student's age (14–21 as of October 1) will be reported based on when the student's exit occurred during the current reporting year.

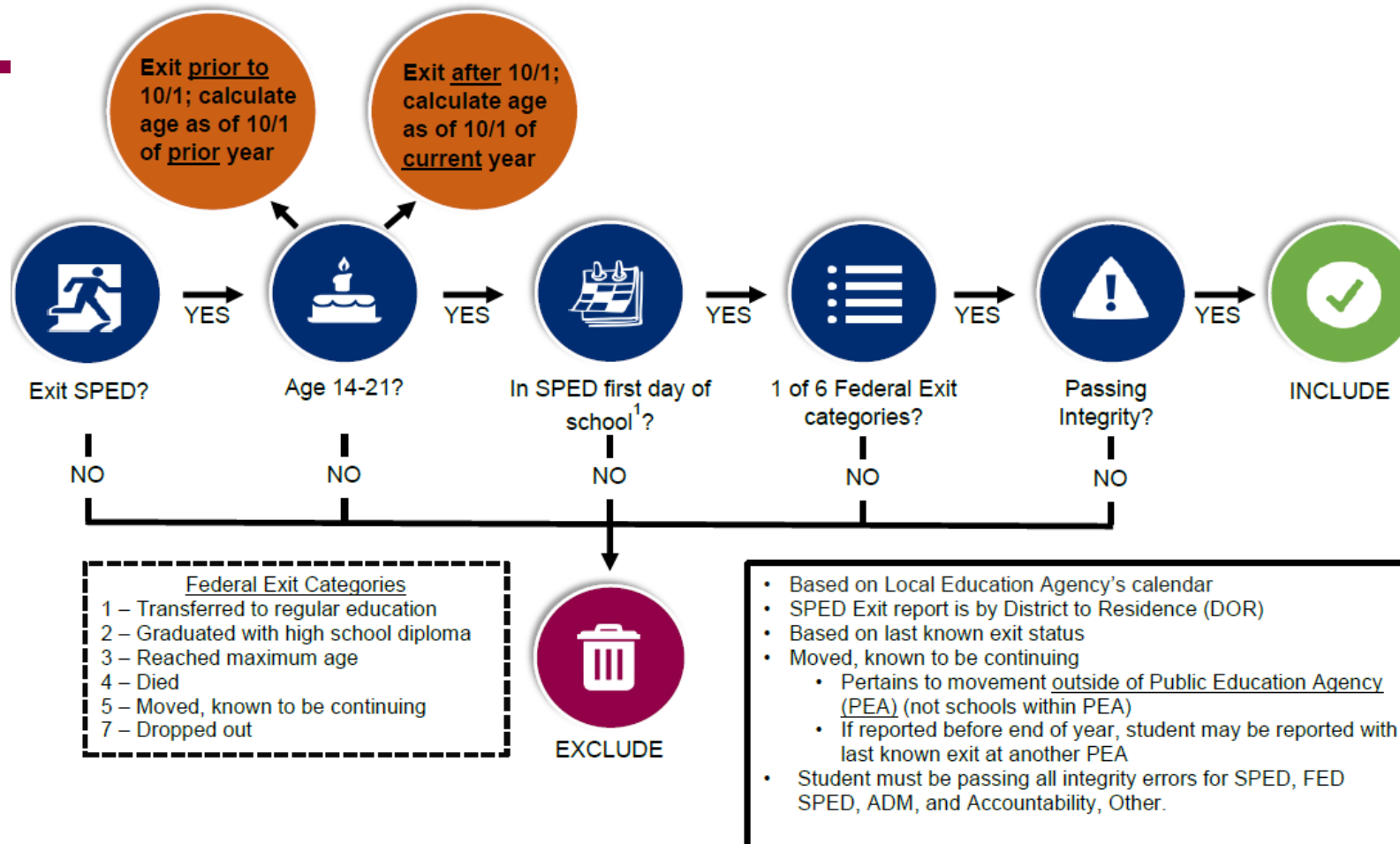

- Average Daily Membership (ADM) (-10XXX, -20XXX)
- Accountability, Other (-21XXX)
- State SPED (-40XXX)
- Fed SPED (-40XXX)

Exit: SPED Program Exit Codes

- Six Federal Exit Categories are
 - SPED01 – Transferred to regular education
 - SPED02 – Graduated with a high school diploma
 - SPED03 – Reached maximum age
 - SPED04 – Died
 - SPED05 – Moved, known to be continuing
 - Student will not populate if they continued services at another PEA
 - SPED07 – Dropped out

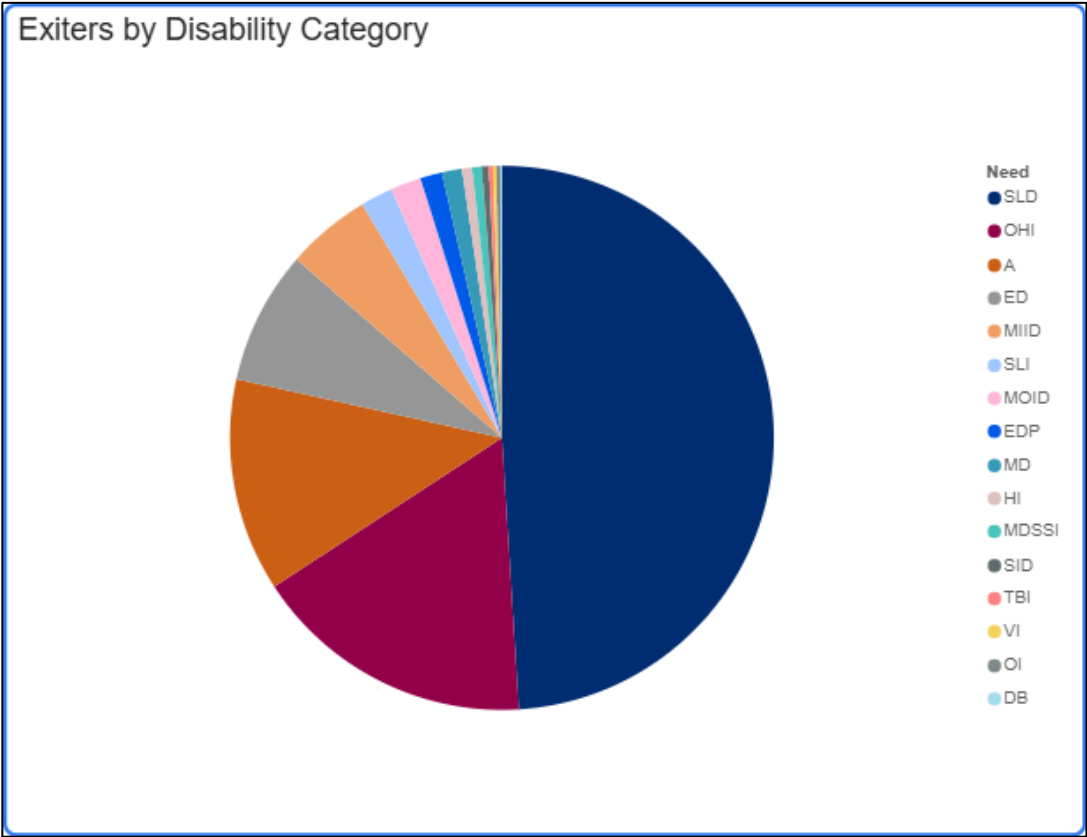
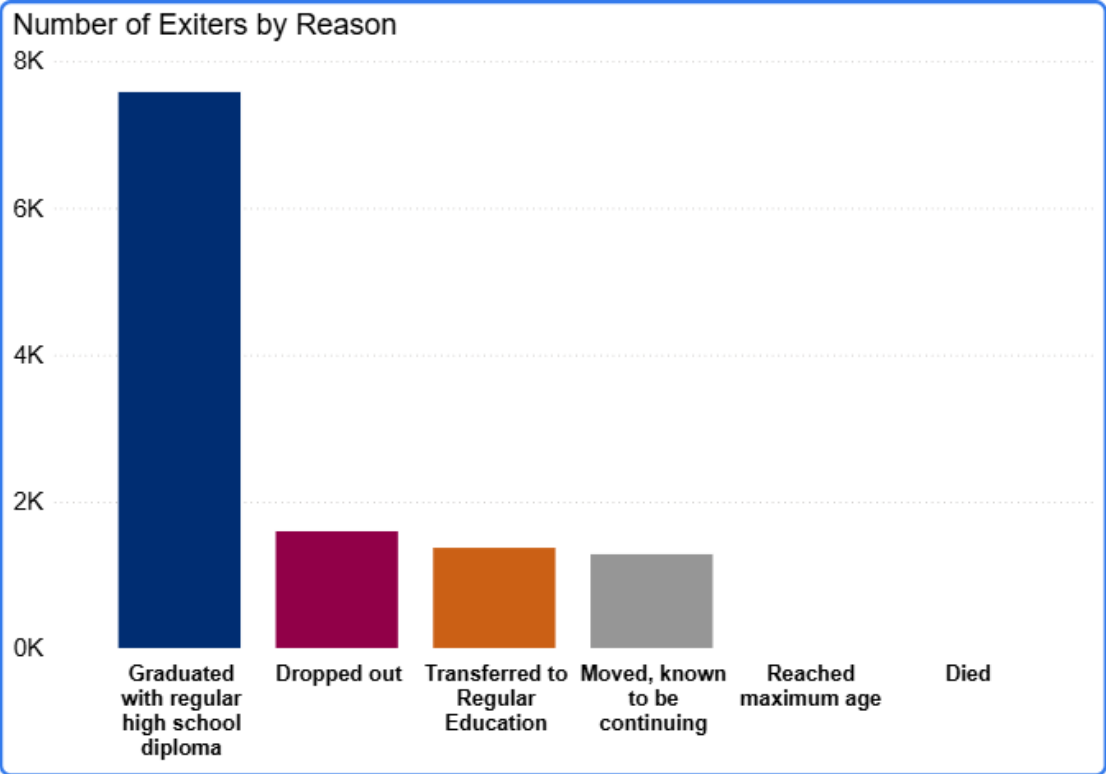

SPED Discipline Reporting Requirements

For a discipline incident to populate in SEDD, the incident must have:

- Involved a student receiving SPED services
- Involved a student between the ages of 3 and 21 years
- Resulted in the student's removal from the educational environment
- Passed integrity at the incident level
- Passed integrity at the student level

SPED Discipline: SPED Services and Age

The student must have been receiving SPED services at the time of the incident.

- If services were ended prior to the discipline incident date, the incident will not be included.
- If services began after the discipline incident date, the incident will not be included.

The student must have been between the ages of 3 and 21, inclusive, at the time of the incident.

SPED Discipline: Removals

The student must have been removed from their educational environment

- Unilateral removals to an Interim Alternative Education Setting (IAES)
- Reassignment to Alternative Education Program In/Out of School
- Reassignment to Alternative to Suspension Program In/Out of School
- Hearing Officer Removal for Likely Injury to Self or Others
- Out-of-School Suspensions
- In-School Suspensions
- Expulsions

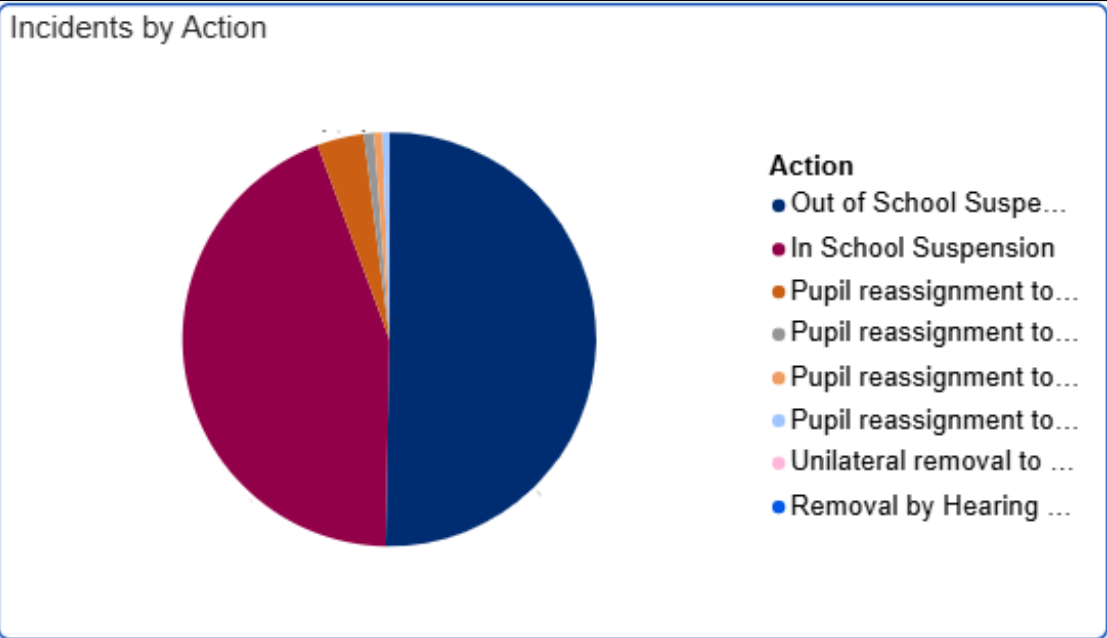
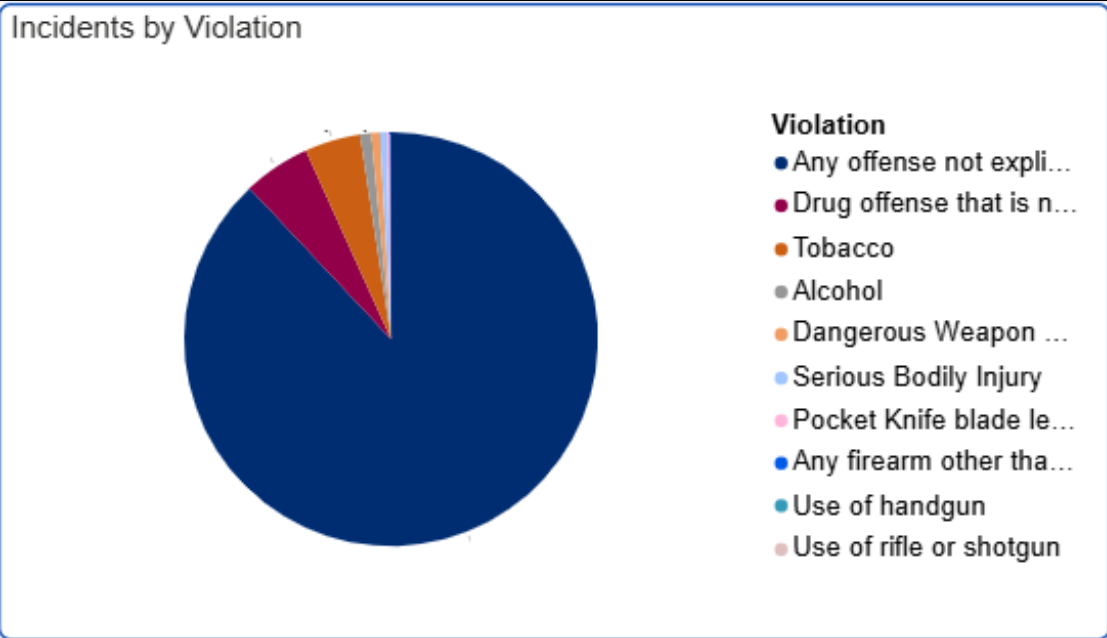

- Indication of whether the student received educational services
- Passed integrity at the incident level
- Passed integrity at the student level

SWOD: No SPED Services

The student must not have been receiving SPED services on the date of the incident

- Check the SPED72 to verify the student:
 - Does not populate
 - Has services begin after incident date
 - Has services end before incident date
