The LEA continues to provide its inmates services during the pandemic including mental health services, education, food and religious services because we are a secure care facility. Staff has access to free mental health services through our Employee Assistance Program.

The LEA continues to provide educational services but does so in compliance with CDC guidelines. The LEA has also expanded its Peer to Peer tutoring program throughout the 10 prisons.

Students have access to licensed mental health providers. The LEA will purchase social-emotional curriculum for implementation in the classrooms.

This may include student health and food services.

The LEA continues to provide NaphCare health services to students and does so in compliance with CDC guidelines. The LEA has also will

continue to provide food to it's students, but in accordance with CDC guidelines via our contracted food provider.

assist staff with exploring options to their situation, and to help staff discover solutions, when possible. The ombudsman is a confidential,

impartial, informal and independent resource available to all staff.

The Ombudsman Office is not an office of record and does not require any type of written documentation whatsoever. It is an

informal process and does not participate in any of the formal disciplinary processes of the agency, although staff will often come to

discuss their options to help them determine how they would like to move forward in a way that feels right to them.

The ombudsman office is available to all ADCRR employees.
