The District has developed a Continuity of Operations plan which has been provided to the state and county. Operations are regularly evaluated and adjusted as needed.

28. How will the LEA ensure continuity of services for students' academic needs?*

The district has added a Saturday School program and has directed teachers to focus on Teach and Reteach during the school day as well as offering tutorial and after school tutoring for grades k-8. When students are quarantined or isolated, instructional and academic support is provided via online platforms. Students are given ample time to make up missing and incomplete assignments.

A full time counseling position has been added. Arrangements have been made to allow for the addition of a part time counselor intern. A middle school elective focusing on social emotional needs and coping skills has been added to the elective schedule. District administration continues to work closely with the county CRC for immediate mental health emergencies.
