The district has hired a board-certified school psychologist and (1 FTE) SEL support staff that provide 24/7 support for all students. Services are provided in-person and on-line. In addition, the district has implemented SEL assessment tool to help ensure all students SEL needs are being addressed and identifies students that need additional SEL support systematically.

The school is providing free lunch and breakfast for all students during the 2022-23 SY and throughout the summer as well. This program has been in place for the past 18 months and will continue its service to children through the coming year and more. The district is the hub of our small rural community and will continue to provide support for our needy families.

The district continue to monitor all staff to help ensure their SEL needs are being meet. Regular activities to support each other are part of our culture. In addition, Dr Linda Ryan, the district school psychologist can meet with staff when needed to discuss issues related to Covid or other areas that are stressful and need a trained professional to talk with.
