Hirsch Academy Face Covering Policy: The guidance is for infection control personal protective equipment (PPE) recommendations aligned with the goals and strategies to respond to the community spread of the Covid-19 virus. "Face covering" refers to a well-fitting reusable or disposable face covering that fully covers the nose and mouth. CDC does not recommend use of face shields for normal everyday activities or as a substitute for cloth face coverings. Hirsch Academy's campus will operate as mask optional as of 04/11/2022. All persons on Hirsch Academy's campus are welcomed to wear a mask but mask usage is not enforced in the exterior or interior of the campus.

Classrooms will be set up to promote social distancing.

- Students are seated at tables or desks to maximize distance between students
- Each classroom will be provided with PPE and cleaning and sanitizing materials to facilitate regular surface cleaning on desks, tables and common areas
- Students will not share classroom supplies like scissors, pencils, crayons, books, etc. All students have been provided individual supplies.
- When possible, classrooms will be set up to reflect same direction seating arrangements or multi directional seating with sneeze guards based on the recommendations of each classroom teacher.

Classroom Handwashing Mitigation: Classrooms with a sink will participate in frequent hand washing throughout the day. Classrooms without a sink will participate in frequent sanitizing throughout the day. Classrooms are taken to sanitize their hands before going to the playground and cafeteria.

Enhanced Cleaning and Sanitizing: All high traffic areas to include the office areas and restrooms will be sanitized frequently throughout the day.

- Student restrooms will be sanitized hourly to include all entry point handles, faucets, urinal and toilet flush valves, hand dryer and paper towel dispenser.
- Each class will wash their hands or use hand sanitizer before and after using the playground.
- Classroom high touch points and students desks will be sanitized throughout the day.

Hirsch will continue to provide top tier academic services and all students services including health and food and social wellbeing in the event of a government shutdown or a community spread level that forces the school out of the building.

28. How will the LEA ensure continuity of services for students' academic needs?*

Hirsch Academy will equip all families with a chromebook (one per family) to participate in daily zoom sessions with teachers.
For families without internet service, Hirsch will also have weekly work packets available for either pickup or drop off.
Hirsch's teachers and assistant staff will host hourly zoom tutoring sessions throughout the day for students that need additional support. All students needing specialized programs will also receive them either virtual or in a one on one setting.

29. How will the LEA ensure continuity of services for students' social, emotional, and mental health needs?*

For any Social, Emotional and Mental Health Needs Hirsch Academy has a dedicated counselor that is available for one on one meetings, virtual meetings, virtual play groups, and house visits.

30. How will the LEA ensure continuity of services for students' other needs?*

Hirsch Academy will provide weekly bag meal service, either pick health and food services) up or delivery, to all students in the event of a shutdown.

Social, Emotional and Mental Health Needs Hirsch Academy remains committed to the support of our staffs social, emotional and mental health needs. In addition to a dedicated counselor, Hirsch provides it's staff with all the latest information from our health insurance providers including ways to contact health professionals when in need.

Hirsch Academy will continue to offer staff meals, trips to the local food banks and extra PPE in the event of a shutdown.
