The following plan describes how RSD will implement the necessary and appropriate activities, supports, and programs for students and staff to ensure the continuity of academic, social, emotional and other wrap-around services. This is in addition to RSD's commitment to continuing to implement its standards-aligned, rigorous curriculum and instruction for all students.

Specific to its instructional program, RSD has developed programs to begin to address lost instructional time including:

Academic Counselor

Additional Administration positions have been created

Additional Teacher positions have been created as needed

Specific to its social, emotional and mental well-being and health supports for students and staff, RSD offers a social, emotional, behavioral program that is teacher driven and overseen by the School Counselor and Administration. These positions' activities are described in more detail below.

28. How will the LEA ensure continuity of services for students' academic needs?*

RSD's overall philosophy to addressing lost instructional time is to provide individual support via a virtual AOI setting as well as small group Zoom sessions to meet students where they are academically and address and identify their struggles within their learning.

RSD will use high-quality assessments, both diagnostic and formative to provide timely information for each student. RSD will support students in tracking their own progress toward closing identified achievement gaps and in their own social-emotional growth.

RSD provides academic support to any student until 6:30 p.m. Monday-Friday

RSD administration, counselor, and teachers will identify individual student gaps in ELA and Mathematic within their coursework and State Assessments.

RSD will provide professional development to learn new instructional strategies specific to the at-risk population and multi-tiered support.

RSD will provide time within the contracted school day for teachers to collaborate to prioritize engaging students.

29. How will the LEA ensure continuity of services for students' social, emotional, and mental health needs?*

Student Supports:

- RSD administers surveys and analyzes results to measure social and emotional well-being of students to improve or revise current practices.
- All teachers have built in time during the school day to provide regular check- ins for students and set aside time to reflect and discuss any needs or areas of concern for students.
- RSD implements the BARR program to address, social-emotional curriculum for all students.
- Weekly blocks are set aside for students to focus on current and relevant social/emotional issues and lessons.
- The RSD counselor is available daily to support student mental health needs
- The RSD Family Engagement Coordinator is in weekly contact with all families to ensure mental health referrals for added supports are timely

Family Supports:

Monthly family and student virtual events are hosted to provide support

Confidentiality is honored for students reporting concerns for student well-being.

Resources and referrals are available along with support from our staff to connect our students with the assistance needed.

Safe & Conducive Learning Environment:

• RSD will continue to provide a safe, welcoming, and inclusive learning environment.

Locating Absent Students:

• Administration and teachers will make every effort to locate families through utilizing emergency contacts in student management system and conducting home visits.

Teacher Training:

- RSD provides professional development to staff to effectively implement supports for the students and families.
- RSD provides professional development to help educators and students

build stronger relationships to increase student engagement.

- School supplies are not required, and any students who are in need will receive materials needed by RSD.
- RSD provides hygiene packs for students who need them in order to have their basic needs met.

- RSD conducts an online survey of stakeholders annually each spring
- Surveys are distributed in English and Spanish
- The survey collects input on existing practices, future programming and support, as well as open-ended request for additional ideas and suggestions for future consideration.
- RSD presents these results at a public Governing Board meeting annually. During this meeting, the community is given an opportunity through public comment to address the Board and provide input or feedback.
- Survey data is compared to baseline data year over year, in terms of feedback on effectiveness, communication, awareness, etc. to monitor progress and growth.
- Open-ended survey responses are analyzed and shared with the leadership team to determine revisions as needed
- Recommendations for revisions are approved by leadership and the Governing Board, as needed.
