What is the AZTRAP?

The Arizona Teacher Registered Apprenticeship Program is an apprenticeship program that allows individuals to gain extensive experience in the classroom under a journeyworker (mentor teacher). AZTRAP utilizes an "Earn and Learn" model, allowing apprentices to earn a living wage through their local education agency while completing related technical instruction through an educator prep program.

Responsibilities
